PRE-SEASON CONDITIONING

Eighteen returning players and freshmen started a two-day a week, nine-week off-season conditioning program on January 3 at Twist Sport Conditioning Center. Workouts at Wilson on the track and in the weight room started February 6, twice a week for two weeks. The mile run and jump rope tests will be held on February 22 and 24. The team selection process starts February 27.



COLLEGE BOUND ATHLETES

If you intend to participate in Division I or II athletics as a freshman in college, you must be registered with and certified as eligible by the NCAA Initial-Eligibility Clearinghouse. This was implemented by the NCAA to ensure consistent interpretation of initial NCAA requirements for incoming freshman.

ACT or SAT scores are mandatory for Division I schools. Core courses are required and are verified by the Clearinghouse. Juniors should take the SAT test and could retake as a senior in October.

Start planning now if you plan to participate in athletics at the college level.
